The natural topography has allowed Fazio to create unique backdrops and framing for each hole, and to fashion a design with great visual variety that combines playability and challenge for golfers of every caliber.

GHN's Domestic Youth Advocacy Programs

Giving Hope Network's Domestic youth advocacy programs are primarily focused on providing access to life's essential needs, improving communication, supporting education, and readying students for employment.

Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of Philadelphia trains and supports community volunteers to advance the welfare of children in foster care through effective advocacy. Volunteers are regular people, from all walks of life, who have been screened and highly trained and receive ongoing support and supervision from CASA staff. Volunteer CASA advocates identify needs, make recommendations to the family court and provide children with a steady, consistent adult presence during this difficult, and often tumultuous, time in their young lives. For many abused and neglected children, their CASA is the one constant

adult presence in their lives when their case manager or foster parents change. Independent research has demonstrated that children with a CASA are substantially less likely to spend time in long-term foster care and less likely to re-enter care.
